





A message from our founder and coordinator

This has been a groundbreaking year for Birmingham Open Studios. In April we launched our first Crowdfunder with 3 targets: 1) to fund a new app to help visitors navigate the event, 2) to improve our visual map, and 3) to grow the event geographically.

Despite not quite hitting our full target, we still managed to achieve all 3 aims. Our new app is coming September (QR code on back page), and we have commissioned local map-maker Tom Woolley to create a visually striking, yet simple map (included).

We have also grown the event to include more of North Birmingham, and we have our first participants from Erdington and Handsworth this year.
